Monica Candelaria Mignone : 24 years, psychologist. She was kidnapped in his home in Santa Fe 2449, 3 º A

Vásquez Ocampo of Lugones Maria Marta: 23 years, psychologist, kidnapped her husband Don (Cesar Amadeo Lugones : 28 years, veterinarian) of its office located in Emilio Mitre 1258, 11 D. Pregnant a month. According to former Marine Adolfo Scilingo gave birth to a boy in the ESMA in January 1977. His son was not yet recovered

Kidnapped on May 14, 1976 with the priests Orlando Yorio and Francisco Jalics, then released. Alfabetizaban in Curapaligüe and Cobo, Villa Bajo Flores. Seen in the ESMA

Arrested at their homes Beatriz Perez Carbonell Weiss and her husband, Horacio Pérez Weiss, Maria Lugones Marta Ocampo de Vazquez and her husband Cesar Amadeo Lugones, Monica Maria Candelaria Mignone. Mary Esther Lorusso Lammler, Monica Quintero (former sister of the Sisters of Mercy). This entire group of tasks performed human, social, religious and political in shantytown Flores (Buenos Aires) in the Parish Mary Mother of the People. By questioning the father suffered Orlando Yorio, it appears they were transferred to the School of Naval Mechanics where after being tortured have been taken in the death flights.

And professionals, service poor brother-town misery of Bethlehem, the capital of Argentina, is now the concrete expression of love and sense of justice who drank in the Gospel. With priests who live or work in that town do days of prayer, catechesis and school support, build a nursery and happy worship with songs and guitars. On that night all are taken from their homes. Monica also Quintero, formerly religious and until shortly before catechist in Bethlehem. A few days later they were kidnapped from the same village Francisco Jalics Jesuit priests and Orlando Yorio and taken to the School of Naval Mechanics to remain missing for six months in inhumane conditions. It is assumed that the same group is involved in both the facts and that Monica and her colleagues are tortured in the same place and then killed. The

efforts of Emilio Mignone, Monica's father, so tied to the church hierarchy, and the father of Maria Marta, diplomat, are useless. They never appear, but his faith, devotion and joy continue to encourage thousands of young people in Latin America

On Sunday, May 10 at noon at Riobamba 165 was the memory footprint. On the trail of the Ateneo de la Juventud tile was installed with the names of young people who met there and were kidnapped by the terrorist state on May 14, 1976. Maria Marta Vasquez, Cesar Lugones, Beatriz Carbonell, Horacio Pérez Weiss and Monica Mignone,

who continue disappeared. Halfway down the block, a group of people occupying the street differently. They had gathered in front of what looked like a large gym. But not talking about sports, or expect to enter a tournament. There stood another story built in the city, at which point it is present now and forever. For linking the past to the future, when time does not dwell oblivion.

"I must confess that I had never been to a tile installation. I did not know what it was" were the first words of Marta Vasquez, President of the Mothers of Plaza de Mayo Founding Line and mom Maria Marta Vasquez. Around him, his companions Carmen Lapacó, Mirta Baravalle, Enriqueta Maroni and Laura Conte and the relatives and friends of the young detainees and missing your voice heard with emotion facing the street noise. All speakers expressed the same, "the kids can not remember the separate". They spent their days and vacation together, at the Ateneo de la Juventud, in the school of the Bajo Flores Bethlehem, in the towns of Patagonia. Were militant Catholics missionaries committed to the most vulnerable. The work in the town and on the south was part of a project of social transformation.

The parents accompanied Ricciardeli and Vernazza, among others, belonging to the Movement of Priests for the Third World. For its sensitivity, solidarity, delivery, clarity and simplicity genocidal dictatorship took them. Because they were able to see, in the eyes of exclusion, where driving the economic model, consumption and individualism. So we can remember, with that love and strength to continue mobilizing, inspiring, challenging. Because they were not indifferent to pain and says "I only ask of God," chanted letter each and everyone present as close to the tribute.

Maria Marta Vasquez, Cesar Lugones, Beatriz Carbonell, Horacio Pérez Weiss and Monica Mignone were kidnapped from their homes in the early hours of May 14, 1976 by members of the Navy. Maria Marta Vasquez and Monica Mignone coursed high school together in the College of Mercy of Belgrano and career of Psychology at the University of El Salvador. Marta Maria Lugones and Cesar were married and expecting their first child. Through the testimonies of survivors and knew they were in the School of Naval Mechanics. There, according to former Marine Adolfo Scilingo, Marta Maria gave birth to a boy in mid-January. To date not been restored identity.


